Dear Parents and Carers,

As I loaded up this week's bulletin, I couldn't quite believe that this was the 100th edition, (doesn't time fly), but this week has been very similar to my previous 99 at Potley Hill with our school being a hive of activity and learning. One of the particular highlights this past week was showing our Hampshire School Advisor around on Thursday as he came to visit us as part Hampshire's school-to-school support system which monitors the quality of education across schools in the county. Mr Dawson spent his time with us looking at the subjects we teach beyond English and Maths whilst also speaking with a number of pupils, school staff and members of the Governing Board. In a similar way to last year this process once again identified many positives about our school, including the high levels of engagement of pupils with their learning, which is due to the structure and content of the curriculum, together with the quality of learning in books. However, just like any monitoring process some next steps were identified, which will be focussed on in the coming months, but it was an informative experience which celebrated the excellent provision on offer to our pupils each and every day.

Part of this offer is the opportunity to represent the school at sporting events and a number of our Year 5 & 6 pupils have done exactly this over the past week including in a netball match against Dogmersfield, whilst others did so in a girls' football tournament at Calthorpe Park. Despite the results being mixed, the pupils involved should feel proud of their contributions when representing the school.

And finally, I would like your support when it comes to online safety because we all know that the use of technology by children comes with its pitfalls. The reason for this support is because we have seen an increase in the number of children saying they use age-inappropriate apps, e.g., Instagram, tiktok, (both of which require them to be 13 to create an account), with some reporting that they have unintentionally seen things on Youtube because their access hasn't been restricted, (using Kidstube instead would help with this).
