School Council Fundraising - Comic Relief on Friday 17th March 2023

On Friday 17th March 2023 Comic Relief is taking place across the country where fundraising events help support the message of ensuring 'a just world, free from poverty.' This is a message that is supported by the School Council too which is why we chose to support the Camberley All Night Café as our charity this year.

As a result, we will be holding two separate fundraising activities to help raise money for Comic Relief and the Camberley All Night Café, with all the money raised being split equally between the two.

Wear red to school - on Friday 17th March pupils can wear non-school uniform but one of the items needs to be red, which is the colour most closely associated with Comic Relief. It could be a red t-shirt, shoes, or even a red accessory in their hair, but for this privilege pupils will need to donate £1.

'Silver Coin Challenge' - throughout next week each class can participate in a 'silver coin' challenge. We believe that this is something the older children at school have done before but the rules are that each class is given a jar and then pupils bring in silver coins over the week to fill it up as much as possible. At the end of the week, the number of coins in each jar, (not the value of the money), are counted and the class that have donated the most coins will win a popcorn and film afternoon later in the term as a reward for their fundraising.

With both these fundraising activities taking place we're sure to raise much needed money for both Comic Relief and the Camberley All Night Café. Thank you for your support.
