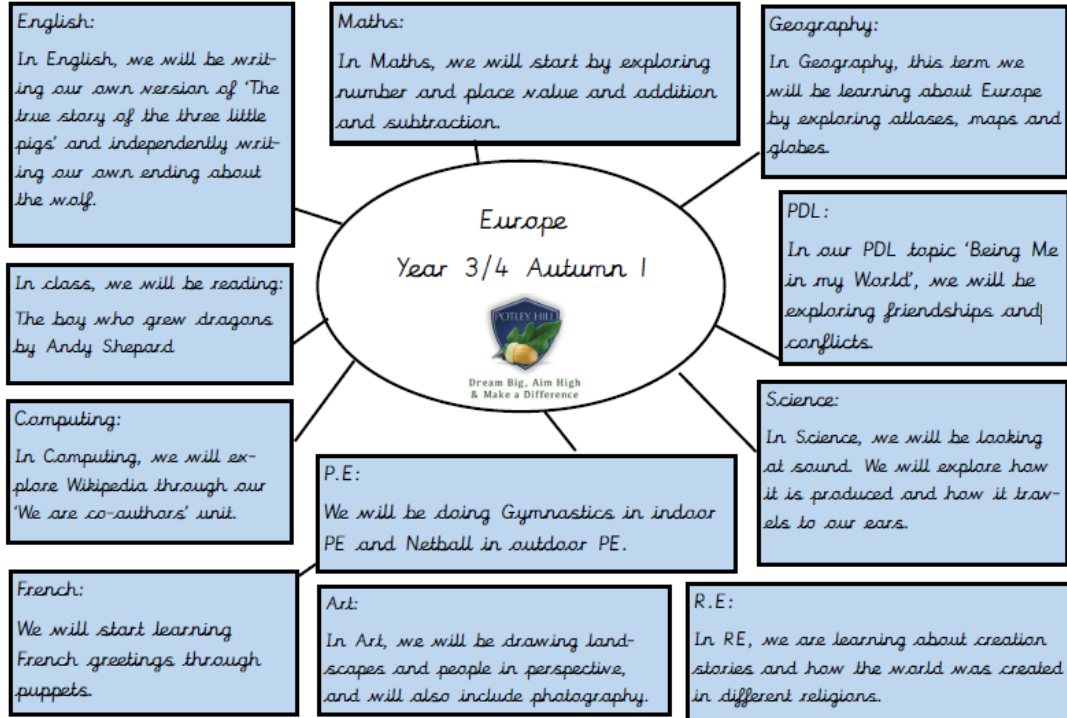
Twitter
