Childrens Hospital Pyjamas

Each year Childrens Hospital Pyjamas collect donations of brand new pyjamas from newborn to age 18 which are then gifted to children in hospital on Christmas morning. In reality, they are also used in other situations where children may have had their clothes cut in A&E, in an emergency situation where there hasn't been time to pack essentials, or where families live a distance from the hospital and to save them from unnecessary travel.

Last year they collected over 15,000 pairs of pyjamas and donated them to 90 establishments. This year the team will be supporting Frimley Park Hospital, Southampton Children's Hospital, Royal Surrey Hospital, Royal Berkshire Hospital, St Peters Hospital, Basingstoke Hospital, Winchester Hospital and two hospices.
