## Pastures New

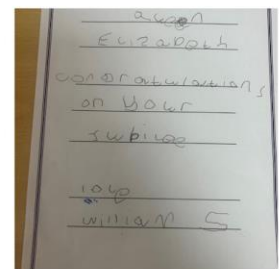
