

Year 1 Recommended Reads

- ◆ You don't have to read every single book; there are lots of choices, so everyone can find something they like.
- ◆ Many of the books are also the start of a series, so you could continue them, or explore other books from that author.
- ◆ Share the book with your child - it still counts as a read book if you read it to them!
- ◆ The books can be found on the year 1 recommended reads shelf. **These are either library copies, or your teachers' own books, so please look after them!**
- ◆ Many of the books can also be found as e-books or audio books on SORA for free.
- ◆ If you can't find a book to read, speak to Mrs Wilding or your teacher.

When you have finished a book:

- ◆ Tick/highlight it and write the date you finished. A copy of the list is also on the website, in case you lose your booklet.
 - ◆ Mark the book as complete on BoomReader!
- ◆ Bring in your Recommended Reads booklet to school when you have read **TEN** of the books, so an adult at school can sign them off and celebrate your brilliant reading!

10 reads = 5 Potley Points

20 reads = 10 Potley Points

30 reads = your very own mufti day!

40 reads = 15 Potley Points

50 reads = 20 Potley Points and a special celebration!

Remember, you can't count books you have read before this year towards your challenge, but you can count books you read this year in class.
